Program Outcome #2 - Program Completion:

- Forty-five percent (45%) of all students who begin in the first NRSG course in the traditional option will complete the AAS in Nursing curriculum in 4 academic semesters.
- Forty-five percent (45%) of all students who begin in the first NRSG course in the LPN-to-RN Career Mobility option will complete the AAS in Nursing curriculum in 3 academic semesters.
- Sixty percent (60%) of all students who begin the first NRSG course in the traditional and LPN-to-RN Career Mobility options will complete the program within one hundred-fifty percent (150%) of the program length. (traditional: 6 semesters; LPN-to-RN:4 semesters)
